

The School

The Center offers qualified Italian language tuition and cultural activities for international language learners of all levels in a personal atmosphere.

Location

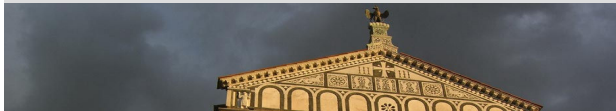


Italian travelling from Florence to Naples
