THE COURSES

A Door to Italy offers a wide variety of general and specialised courses, geared to the specific needs of our students.

Courses are catered for groups or individuals coming from different countries and with different purposes. General language and cultural courses are available all year round.

More targeted courses offer Italian for professionals, such as Italian for business, Italian for professional interpreters and Italian for teachers.

Language classes are aimed at developing the student's general language competence and the ability to communicate in an international environment and in everyday situations, as well as at work and in social life situations. Throughout the course, learners expand their vocabulary repertoire and learn new grammatical structures, which they practice in the context and, further, they improve their ability to communicate, read and write fluently and correctly. At school we use the communicative method, preferring oral communication but not disregarding aspects of written ability, focusing on the four language abilities (listening, speaking, reading, writing).





THE GENERAL ITALIAN LANGUAGE AND CULTURE COURSES

STANDARD COURSE

• Lessons in small groups.

• 20 lessons/week from Monday through Friday

The Standard course is the best way for students of all six ability levels, from the beginner A1 to the advanced C2, to join grammar and conversation. Groups are heterogeneous, multilingual and small and this helps to ensure that the students are given personal attention and the opportunity for self-expression.

INTENSIVE COURSES

· Lessons in small groups + Inidividually

• 20 lessons/week in the morning + individual lessons in the afternoon.

Choice is among 4, 6, 8 or 10 hours of individual lessons per week. The intensive course is best for all students who desire to learn as much as possible in a short period of time.

The intensive programs have always been successful because the individual lessons are very good at establishing and fixing new aspects of the language. During private lessons teachers create a tailor made program to let the student face and solve learning difficulties.

ITALIANO FACILE

· Lessons in small groups.

• 12 lessons shared in 3 days/week

The Italiano Facile course is suitable for students from the A2 level and over. The course is particularly suggested with a minimum attendance of 4 weeks, but it available also for shorter period.

EXTENSIVE EVENING COURSE

· Lessons in small groups.

• 1,5 hour/lesson twice a week in the evening time,

This gives workers the possibility to learn or improve the language after their work schedule.

The course is also held for all the levels

INDIVIDUAL or DUO COURSE

Lessons are 'one-to-one' or in very small groups of 2 students with similar language ability. The program is completely customized, following students' knowledge and needs.

Considering the extreme flexibility of the schedule and attendance, it is particularly suitable for busy people. The individual course or duo course are also suitable for those people who attend a standard course, but having little time to stay in Italy, they desire to use the individual hours to dive as deep into the language as possible.

Individual and semi-individual classes can also focus on cultural programs or on business Italian.

50+ PROGRAM

This course is thought for over-fifties that desire to get deeper into Italian language and discover Genoa and its surroundings during a pleasant study holiday.

It is a 2 weeks intensive program, which includes Italian lessons in the morning, cultural and gastronomic activities and excursions in the afternoon and over the weekend.

All activities are in Italian language, accompanied by a one person from A Door to Italy's staff.

ITALIAN FOR FAMILIES

A 2-weeks programme for families with children, from 6 years old. Language classes, held in small groups, take place in the morning, leisure activities in the afternoon.

Parents' lessons and children classes have same schedule, to help families organizing their language studies. Leisure activities, instead, are thought and planned to let them live a vacation all together.

ONLINE LESSONS

Individual classes via Skype are the best solution to keep in touch with the Italian world and to learn Italian directly from home or office, following your schedule and needs.

During online lessons the student will develop conversation, refresh vocabulary and grammar, correct past exercises, as it is in a live lesson.

CERTIFICATION COURSES CELI, CILS, AIL

We propose specific INDIVIDUAL courses, to prepare the student to the exam through the analysis of the past papers. Individual lessons are available all year round depending on student's needs and plans.

Lessons can be easily combined to the standard language course.

SPECIAL FOR WORKING

Sectorial language is available for students with a good level of Italian (at least B1). It is aimed to improve a specific language field.

The program is individual and tailored upon students' needs.

SPECIAL FOR TEACHERS

A Door to Italy offers the teachers of Italian language different opportunities for their career.

<u>Observational training for new teachers</u> with no or little experience: new teachers take part to all the phases of the preparation of the teaching material and lessons for all the groups (A1 - C2). They participate to the oral and written testing, to the daily briefing, to the preparation of the role play, the games and songs.

The school is DILS-PG (I and II degree) exam centre. <u>For experienced teachers LS/L2</u> in Italy or abroad: teachers can participate to the 1 or 2 week programmes, based on the teorical and practical professional development, through the work on the four language abilities, such as use of listening, reading, speaking and writing exercises, activities, games, to create a pleasant atmosphere and to push students to speak.

SPECIAL FOR INTERPRETERS AND TRANSLATORS

A Door to Italy works with interpreters of the European Institutions since 10 years.

Our offer includes:

<u>Group course in small groups</u> focused on real and updates listening exercises to improve lexical and cultural understanding; <u>Practical Training</u> lead individually and shaped on the student's personal and professional needs.

<u>Cultural course called "Viaggio in Italia"</u> a 360 ° excursus on contemporary Italian culture, politics, economy and society, through the voice of its protagonists.

The course is addressed to professional interpreters and interpreting students who have almost finished their studies. Course goals: improvement of general and sectorial language; development of anticipation skills; analyses on basic grammatical elements (connectives, conversational signals, verbs, substantives); full comprehension of oral language; general knowledge of Italian society, politics, history and culture. Learning techniques include audio and written texts. Listening and interpreting (simultaneous, consecutive, chochutage), intense and stimulating activities, articles and cloze tests developing lexical skills, improvement of grammar in anticipating, textual coherence and cohesion analysis.

Teaching material is entirely authentic and up to date.



LANGUAGE PLUS... COURSES

Students may desire to deep the local culture or to enrich their experience in Italy combining the study of the Italian language in the morning, to other classes taken in the afternoon.

A Door to Italy offers the students different possibilities:

... COOKING

Individual or small groups

Cooking lessons are dedicated to students whishing to taste and experience local food and learn cooking Italian and Genoese famous dishes.

Teacher not only explains but shows to students, who are involved practically in the preparation of the recipes.

Finally the class tastes the prepared food, which is also considered an unforgettable moment of socialization.

It is also possible to follow special cooking lessons based upon special recipes.

... OPERA SINGER AND LIBRETTI

The purpose of this course, addressed to Opera singers, is to perfect pronunciation through opera's libretti reading and to perfect intonation with singing lessons with a professional singing teacher. During winter courses, participants will have the possibility to go to the Carlo Felice Opera's Theatre with special price reductions for our students.

... DIVING

It is designed for adventurous people wishing to combine a full cultural experience with a unique dive vacation exploring the Ligurian Sea, the gulf and its beauties.

It is possible to have single diving sessions r to take the Open Water Dive Certificate (for those who have not dived before) or the Advanced Open Water Dive certificate, with PADI instructors.

Minimum necessary attendance is 2 weeks.

All didactic materials and the equipment regarding the diving lessons are provided by the diving school and are included in the

... PHOTOGRAPHY

Lessons are in small groups or individually.

Nowadays the ability of taking good pictures is appreciated. Even though people do not need for professional purposes, improving shooting abilities and knowledge of different technogues answers to the growing demand of those who want to photograph for passion or for socialization. The course is held by a professional photographer.

... POTTERY

Lessons are in small groups or individually. The course is based on ceramic laboratory and textile printing. Courses are suitable for children and for adults, for non experienced people or for people who have knowledge in this field. The pottery courses represent a good moment of socialization and a relaxing moment of self expression.

LONG TERM COURSES

THREE-MONTH COURSE - SEMESTER COURSE - ROUND YEAR COURSE

- Lessons in small groups.
- 20 lessons/week from Monday through Friday

The ideal minimum stay for a language course should be 12 weeks: during this period, the student will have more confidence in the language skills throughout a complete full immersion in the Italian culture and way of life. Taking part to a long-term course, students acquire the minimum level necessary to enter Italian University if they need and they can also take advantage of their Italian Long-Term course by taking an internationally recognized certification (CELI, CILS, AIL, PLIDA) while living in Italy.

STUDY ABROAD PROGRAMS FACULTY LED PROGRAMS

A Door to Italy is pleased to cooperate with Schools and Universities to provide academic programs.

The main goal of a study abroad experience is to provide the

opportunity to increase one's international education and student career in an international environment,

while studying Italian language and culture fully immersed in local life, culture, history, traditions, territory,

A Door to Italy provides all the services for an all-inclusive program: logistics, accommodation, Italian language and culture courses, specific courses in the humanities (available in Italian and English), in-company meetings, trips and excursions.

The school and teachers have a long experience in teaching Italian to foreign students who are deaf, involving them in all the activities foreseen by the normal program. For them there are available placements in companies, Italian language courses, culinary courses and LIS courses, Italian Sign Language.



ACCOMMODATION

A Door to Italy offers a wide range of housing options, from basic accommodation up to the high level solution, close to school in the city centre, to guarantee our students a pleasant stay.
